

Assign Status Magento Default [STORE VIEW]

To manage the extension settings please go to System -> Configuration -> Mass Order Actions

Enable order actions, which should be available on the Order Grid.

If you set 'Notify Customer' option for 'Yes', this setting will be pre-selected on the Order Grid.

Select which status should be assigned to orders after actions are applied.

Default Title for Custom Carrier	Custom Carrier ▲ Will be shown in the carriers dropdown for the `custom` option, if the setting below is set to `No`.
Show Custom Carrier Title at the Order Grid	Yes
Set Carrier Title	No ▲ If Custom Carrier Title is not filled at the Order Grid.

For 'Ship' action you can choose if notifications should be sent to customers after the actions is applied to orders. You can also choose status which orders should get.

Choose shipping carrier which will be selected by default.

Specify the name of custom carrier. You can make it available for selection in the Order Grid.
