








Features:

Customizing order numbers is an important feature for any e-commerce store. Now you have a Magento 2 tool which lets you hide business information about the number of orders you're getting and change order numbers according to your management or legal needs.









MAGENTO 2 CUSTOM ORDER NUMBER FEATURES:

- **Hide real order numbers** from competitors and customers;
- **Build a new order number** with the help of the variables;
- **Adjust number counter steps**, reset counters manually or on schedule, use prefixes and postfixes for other documents;
- Use the same **number generation type** for shipping docs, invoices and credit memos or set up individual algorithms to generate numbers for these docs.

General

Enabled [STORE VIEW]

Allows to add set of products to any search, but might slow down the pages in some cases

Timezone offset

You can set custom order number format using different variables. This order number will replace basic Magento order numbering.

Order

Number Format [STORE VIEW]

You can use variables {counter}, {store}, {yyyy}, {yy}, {m}, {mm}, {d}, {dd}, {rand}. If you type ORD-{yy}-{mm}-{dd}-{counter} in the field, you will have order numbers of the kind: ORD-13-08-15-000077
