**Submit filters on desktop (on mobile)** - Select *Instantly* mode to apply filters one by one, on the fly. With the *By Button Click* mode, customers will be able to apply multiple filters in bulk after clicking an *Apply* button.

**Leave the Single-Select Filter Visible after Selection** - Disable the setting to hide the filter when the value is selected.

**Number of Unfolded Options in State** - Specify the number of unfolded options. To see other options, a customer should click the 'More' button.

**Slider Settings** - Here you can choose the style and color for a Price Slider. There are 5 options available for now: Default, Improved, Volumetric Gradient, Light, Dark.

**Exclude 'Out of Stock' Configurable Options from Navigation** - Set to 'Yes' to hide out-of-stock configurable products options and parent configurable products from the search results if the configurable products don't have an option by which the filtering went.

Please mind, that to make the Exclude 'Out of Stock' Configurable Options from Navigation option visible, you should go to Stores  $\rightarrow$  Configuration  $\rightarrow$  Catalog  $\rightarrow$  Inventory  $\rightarrow$  Stock Options and make sure that the option Display Out of Stock Products is set to 'Yes'.

### **Configure the connection to Elastic Search**

To manage a connection to Elastic Search, please navigate to **Stores**  $\rightarrow$  **Configuration**  $\rightarrow$  **Elastic Search**  $\rightarrow$  **Connection** 

To enable the extension, in the **Search Engine** field, select the *Amasty ElasticSearch*. Alternatively, select *MySQL*, to disable the extension.

**Elasticsearch Server Hostname** - Specify a host name or IP address of a machine that runs Elasticsearch. (localhost or 127.0.0.1 by default).Get this value via Magento Cloud.

**Elasticsearch Server Port** - Set the Elasticsearch web server proxy port. In our example, the port is 9200.Get this value via Magento Cloud.

**Elasticsearch Index Prefix** - Specify a particular prefix for each store that you employ elastic search for.

I.e. If you use a single Elasticsearch instance for more than one Magento installation (for instance, *Staging* and *Production* environments), specify a unique prefix for each installation.

**Enable Elasticsearch HTTP Auth** - Select '*Yes*', if you have enabled authentication for your Elasticsearch server. Specify a user name and password in the pop-up fields.

**Elasticsearch Server Timeout** - here you can set the timeout. Enter the number of seconds before the system times out. The default value is 15.
